A Plan for our Parish

Bubbenhall Parish Council working with the Parishes of Baginton, Stoneleigh and Ashow has started developing a joint neighbourhood plan for our area.

What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

Neighbourhood planning gives communities direct power to develop a shared vision for their neighbourhood and shape the development and growth of their local area.

A neighbourhood plan is a new type of planning policy document for a local area. Once adopted it will form part of the local plan for the Local Authority and is used to consider all planning application in that area. Neighbourhood Plans can establish general planning policies for the development and use of land in a parish.

A Neighbourhood plan can inspire local people and businesses to consider other ways to improve their neighbourhood than through the development and use of land. They may identify specific action or policies to deliver these improvements. Wider community aspirations than those relating to development and use of land can

be included in a neighbourhood plan.

How you can become involved

The neighbourhood plan must reflect the views of local people. Over the next few months we will need to contact all residents and businesses in the parish to get your views. We will be interested in everyone's opinion both young and old. Please watch out for posters and emails informing you how to get involved and shape the future of Bubbenhall.



The Programme for the Plan

In order to produce the plan we need to go through a number of stages before the plan can be adopted.

Bubbenhall Community First Responders

On Wednesday 21st October, I had great pleasure in presenting Sarah Cooke School of Dance a Certificate of Appreciation as a token of thanks from Bubbenhall Community First Responders for the donation raised from the Spring Dance Show in May. We really appreciate this support from Sarah and her dance pupils.

To date, Bubbenhall group of Community First Responders have attended 184 incidents with patient's ages between 3 years and 98 years.

Arrangements are still in hand to relocate the Public Access AED (defibrillator) to an outside wall of the Malt Shovel, this will give the village 24 hour access to this potentially lifesaving equipment. We have made an application for listed building consent to site the heated cabinet on the Malt Shovel wall. This is currently being processed and we hope to have a decision from WDC shortly.

Two Basic life Support workshops were successfully held in July for villagers and both were well attended. There are plans to run more workshops next year, but due to our waiting list we are running one further session on Sunday 15 November, commencing at 6pm for two hours. These sessions are free of charge to attend and include instructions and technique to apply CPR and the use of the AED in life threatening situations. No prior knowledge is necessary. If you would like to attend or refresh your skills please contact Dave Bevan or any CFR.

We held another of our famous quiz nights on the 20th September. The winning team were "Norfolk n' Chance" and the wooden spoon was captured by the "We're Stuck



Already" team. Thank you everyone for attending and we raised over £250. Following the success of the quiz night, we are going to run a bingo night on Sunday 29th November in The Malt Shovel. Further details will be sent out via the Bubbenhall mailing list and advertised on posters in the village nearer the date.

A further date for your calendar will be our Annual General Meeting, this will be held on 29th February 2016 commencing at 7pm.

Finally, we are looking for volunteers to become First Responders and join our group. You do not need any medical knowledge or first aid training. After the initial training carried out by West Midlands Ambulance Service, your commitment would be 20 hours of your time per month, to be

available to the community in the case of life threatening emergencies. If you would like to become involved or support Bubbenhall First Responders, and would like further information, please contact any of the Trustees below who will be very happy to chat to you.

Ryton Pools

It has been some time since we last contributed to this newsletter. Somehow good intentions never materialised into an actual article (excuses excuses)! Anyway, better late than never.

There is plenty to report. Last winter saw us doing battle with bramble along the main entrance. For many years we had done little more than keep the road clear, so we decided it was high time we gave the main entrance some TLC. The density of the bramble and dog rose was remarkable, and took all the dedication of staff and volunteers to beat it into submission! The Warwickshire County Council Forestry team undertook some much needed thinning of the larger trees.

The result was an entrance that feels much more open and welcoming. Safer too, with increased visibility through the snaking bends. It also made a lovely feature of 'Drive Pool', a hitherto concealed, though picturesque pond, that can now be seen on the way in. A range of ornamental lilies have been planted in here, and as they establish over the next few years should really put on a show.

We are continuing this work over the coming winter. If anyone follows us on Facebook (and if not, then please do!) you will have seen the levelling work we have had done beside Drive Pool. This area will be established with wild flowers and other plants to enhance both the ecology and aesthetics.

Our Apprentice Ranger Ben Taylor has done a great job of converting a redundant scrap of ground into a productive allotment plot. 'Fruit Corner' is situated at the end of the

Courtyard Play Area, nearest the Visitor Centre. It has a range of soft fruit bushes including several vintage varieties that don't get much of an airing these days. It is well interpreted too, so if you want to know more just take a look!

Families had fun on our events over the summer, with many being very well attended. The Young Anglers fishing tutorial event stood out as doing particularly well. All of the sessions were fully booked, and more often than not, the fish themselves were extremely obliging, with some really good catches being had. One lucky girl even landing a tench of several pounds!

We are also very excited at the prospect of replacing the play area in the courtyard!

We will be applying for a grant from WREN (Waste Recycling Environmental Group) to part fund this work, as we did with the Foothills Play Area in 2012. We will be consulting with our visitors on the detail in due course, but for now we would really appreciate your support in the form a simple signature!

If you like the idea of a new and exciting playground please pop into the Visitor Centre (open 11am-2.30pm weekdays and 11am-3.30pm at the weekends) and sign the Petition of Support. This will be crucial for us put in a successful bid to WREN.



Thank you in advance for your help, and watch this space! I hope to see some of you at Ryton Pools again very soon.

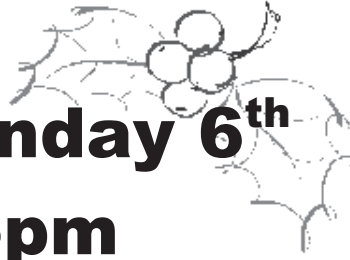

Choir and Altar Servers

At St Leonard's, Ryton, we have a robed choir which includes older children (aged about 8 and upwards) and teenagers: anyone whose son/daughter likes singing might consider encouraging them to join the choir.

New adult choir members always welcome too: If you enjoy singing and would like to join either the robed choir who sing for services twice a month, or the augmented choir (not robed) who sing for special events such as the Carol Service, please contact Barbara Marsh - 7630 4295. You do not have to be able to sight-read music - we are all learning!

We also offer the opportunity for children, young people and adults to train to become altar servers at the Parish Communion services at both Bubbenhall and Ryton churches.

Although we do not at present have the resources to run regular services for children at Bubbenhall, we love having children in our churches, and there is always provision for them at the 9.30am services at Ryton. All families with babies and children are sure of a warm welcome whenever they can join us. All Ryton Sunday morning services start at 9.30am, and the pattern is:

2nd Sunday in every month: Village Worship

The most informal of all our services. We start in the Church Centre (warm and welcoming) with workshop activities for children, and coffee, puzzles and chat for grown-ups to get to know one another. At about 10am we move into church for a short and child-centred service. There is no need to be there on the dot of 9.30am - people drift in as soon as they can make it.

4th Sunday: Family Service

An all-age service of readings, songs and activities with everybody young and old in church together. Children always participate in the readings/drama sketches etc. and several people bring instruments to

accompany the songs (and any other musicians among you and your children would be very welcome to join them). Tea/coffee and cake after the service in the Church Centre.

1st and 3rd Sundays: Parish Communion with Sunday School

Tea/coffee and the chance to socialise after every service. Children start the service in church with their parents, and after the first hymn go out for Sunday School activities in the Church Centre, returning to receive a blessing at the time of Communion. Parents are welcome to accompany their little ones to Sunday School and stay with them if they lack confidence at first. Families from Bubbenhall are especially welcome at all these services.

Confirmation

There is still time to start on confirmation preparation for adults and young people. If you would like to be included, or know someone who would like to be confirmed, or would simply like more details about what confirmation entails, please get in touch with the Rector or Rosemary if you have not already done so.

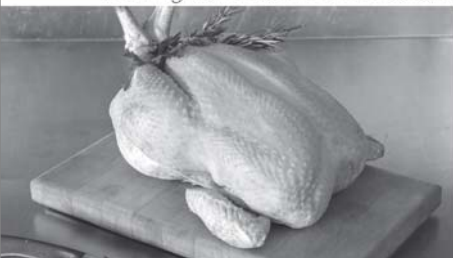

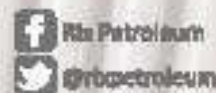

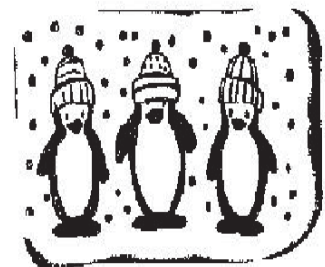
