


# Lanarkshire Slim Planter

Large capacity steel planter in 3mm zintec steel, with single galvanized steel liner and two gold alloy bands as standard.




This steer planter is attractive and has a relatively long product life. However it will need to be repainted every five years.




This wooden planter is treated and has a can be expected to have a reasonable product life.
