High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We are carrying out multiple works to progress the construction of Rugby Road realignment. The work for the realignment will be carried out in several phases next year. As part of the first phase of construction, there will be a closure on Rugby Road to enable the permanent road realignment.

We will be required to complete multiple utility diversions in readiness for the final tie-in works to form the new bridge, this is being built offline next to the existing road. During the closure, we will be constructing part of the embankments either side of the overbridge, strengthening the road and repositioning the plant crossing. This will enable us to carry out further earthworks and reduce the impact on the highway as we progress the new alignment of Rugby Road.

When these works will take place

To carry out the works safely, we will need to close Rugby Road. The closure will be in place 24/7 from **Monday 23 September to Friday 18 October 2024.** A fully signposted diversion will be in place during the closure with access to all properties maintained throughout. Rugby Road will remain open for pedestrians and cyclists. See map on the next page.


